



# Fast Facts: Children, Families and Early Education in Beverly

## Early Education and Care in Beverly

- According to the 2000 Census, 47.5% of 3-5 year-olds in Beverly are enrolled in preschool.
- Of those children enrolled in preschool in Beverly, 106 (14.7%) attend public school pre-kindergarten, according to the Department of Education. The remaining 85.3% are enrolled in community-based or family child care programs.
- In Beverly, there is one public school preschool program, 21 licensed center-based programs, and 28 licensed family child care programs, according to the Department of Education.
- As of January 2007, 76 children age 0-14 were on a waiting list to receive a child care subsidy from the Department of Early Education and Care, of which 21 are of preschool-age (2.9-5 years).
- The Department of Early Education and Care estimates that 324 of Beverly's jobs are in the early education and care industry.
- The average salary of a preschool teacher in the Boston Metropolitan Area is \$28,820, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
