Early Education and Care in Bourne

- According to the 2000 Census, 55.1% of 3-5 year-olds in Bourne are enrolled in preschool.
- Of those children enrolled in preschool in Bourne, 66 (17%) attend public school pre-kindergarten, according to the Department of Education. The remaining 83% are enrolled in community-based or family child care programs.
- In Bourne, there is one public school preschool program, 10 licensed center-based programs, and 14 licensed family child care programs, according to the Department of Early Education Care.
- As of January 2007, 56 children ages 0-14 in Bourne were on a waiting list to receive a child care subsidy from the Department of Early Education and Care, of whom 16 are of preschool-age (2.9-5 years).
- The Department of Early Education and Care estimates that 91 of Bourne's jobs are in the early education and care industry.
- The average salary of a preschool teacher in the Barnstable-Yarmouth Area is \$26,440, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
