Early Education and Care in Hardwick

- According to the 2000 Census, 40.4% of 3-5 year-olds in Hardwick are enrolled in preschool.
- 87 children in the Quabbin Regional School District are enrolled in a public school pre-kindergarten program.
- In Hardwick, there is 1 licensed center-based programs, and 2 licensed family child care programs, according to the Department of Early Education and Care.
- As of January 2007, 3 children ages 0-14 in Hardwick were on a waiting list to receive a child care subsidy from the Department of Early Education and Care, of which 0 are of preschool-age (2.9-5 years).
- The Department of Early Education and Care estimates that 7 of Hardwick's jobs are in the early education and care industry.
- The average salary of a preschool teacher in the Worcester area is \$28,770, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
